Amendment to By-Laws Passed

The Sun Coast Cruisers leadership has made the following change to Section 2 of our by-laws. The amendment was read during our August meeting and was voted on during our September meeting. The new change will allow new members to join late in the year without incurring the full cost of membership. The change will also change the membership classification of individuals and families.

Section 2. There are two types of memberships available. Annual dues shall be payable in advance of the beginning of the membership year, which starts in December 1 and ends on November 30 of the following year, or, when applying for membership. New membership applications that are received between September 1 and November 1 will have the normal membership fee reduced to \$15.00. They will then be required to meet the financial obligation of \$25.00 dues after December 1 for the coming year. Membership applications received between November 2 through November 30 will be required to pay the full \$25.00 fee and will receive credit for the coming year membership fee. If membership is denied the full amount provided with the candidates application will be returned immediately.

Membership - \$25.00 per year, this membership allows the adults recorded on the membership application with the ability to each vote on club issues and officers. This membership is for individuals, families of two or more people, it also includes people who are living together as equal partners. Children under the age of 18 are also included, however, they are not allowed voting privileges.

Associate/Social Membership - \$25.00 per year, this membership is for local businesses, families or individuals who are interested in the social aspects the club has to offer and has no interest in the clubs government or politics and do not wish to have voting privileges.



Teddy Bear Campaign

The Governor of North Carolina, Mike Easley, has declared the month of August as Missing Children's Month. In order to recognize this important event CUE is conducting its annual Teddy Bear Campaign at the steps of Wilmington's City Hall. The program has several benefits. The money donated during this event will benefit CUE while the teddy bears will be given to New Hanover Law enforcement agencies to be used at accident scenes or other tragedies that involve children. The bears help reduce the tension and confusion with the children and the program has been extremely successful. The Sun Coast Cruisers will drive in a convoy to city hall and park in front of the steps and support this CUE event.
