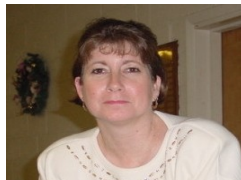
Due to limited space during last months newsletter several award winners were not printed. Therefore, these additional pictures are for your enjoyment.

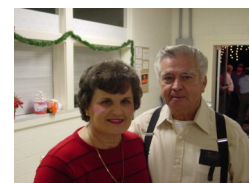
